LOCATION: Bloomington, Illinois

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all competitors born in 2002 or later. **All competitors must be individual members of USA Shooting.** Please have your USA Shooting membership number with you the day of the match.

RESIDENCE: Each competitor may claim residence in only one state, residency must be declared on entry form. Residents are eligible for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place USA Shooting State Champion medallions. Residency is defined as to where the competitor holds a valid drivers license. If the competitor does not have a drivers license, residency is then defined as to where the competitor's parents/guardians reside. Non-residents are encouraged to compete for invitations to the National Championship. Non-residents are not eligible for state awards.

ENTRY: Only scores from a registered State Junior Olympics match will count for invitation to the National Junior Olympic match will count for invitations to the National Junior Olympic Championship. Shooters MAY NOT compete in more than one state JOSOC. Juniors who fire in their own state will not be allowed to shoot in another state. Juniors from states which are not holding a state JOSOC, and those who cannot attend their own state JOSOC, will be allowed to enter as a non-resident in another state. Non-residents should declare their home state at entry and are not eligible for state resident awards.

CATEGORIES: The following categories will be used for the competition: (based on age in 2023)  
Junior (J1)-age 18-20-competitors born 2003 to 2005; Intermediate Junior (J2)-age 15 to 17-competitors born from 2006 to 2008; Sub-Junior (J3)-age 14 and under- competitors born 2009 and later.

RULES: THE 2014 EDITION OF USA SHOOTING WILL GOVERN.

COURSE OF FIRE: Women's Air Rifle-standing, 60 shots  
Men's Air Rifle-standing, 60 shots  
Smallbore rifle (men and women)-3 position (kneeling, prone, standing) 60 shots

COACHING: Coaching on the firing line will NOT be permitted.

SCORING PROTESTS: A scoring protest of \$1.00 per shot will be charged.

TIES: All ties will be broken in accordance with USA Shooting Rules.

PARTICIPATION PINS: A Junior Olympic participation pin provided by USA Shooting will be given to each competitor.

AWARDS: USA Shooting will provide a gold medallion for the top resident individual, silver medallion for the 2<sup>nd</sup> place resident individual and a bronze medallion for the 3<sup>rd</sup> place resident individual. Awards are given based on match score only and not finals.

MAKE ENTRY: Entries will complete an entry form at the match facility.
